Hello all,

I hope this email finds you healthy and in good spirits as we continue to work through this pandemic as a community. I am sending you all this email because I consider you all friends and those in our community who DO. You are the leaders in this community, and as you might have heard, our Census numbers are embarrassingly low compared to other cities. We began to market Census 2020 before COVID-19 and were in the process of forming a complete count committee. Much of that work was derailed due to COVID-19, and we are now reassessing. We've put out a new video and graphic ads on social media, and the city website. Senior Services has been working with our elderly community. This week flyers are going out with the water bills for the next eight weeks as reminders to respond to the Census. We've also been giving out info at all of our food distributions, which have been happening every two weeks. We have additional plans that will be unfolding in the next couple of months – since the deadline has been pushed to October.

So, I am reaching out to all of you because I need your help motivating your friends and neighbors to respond to the Census. Below is the Facebook link to the most recent video we shot with the Mayor. Please go to the link and "Share" it to your Facebook pages if you can. What we fail to do in this Census will affect our city for the next 10 years. We will be passed up for essential general funding for hospitals, clinics, schools, public safety, roads, public works, and other vital programs. The Census

response affects redistricting, fair representation in the House of Representatives, and meaningful community initiatives. We cannot let that happen! Please help us get the word out. The second link
